



ACCESSING CREDIT, GRANTS AND FUNDING

FOR A PROJECT EVEREST INTERNSHIP



Every semester, universities battle to cater to the growing industry demand for career-ready graduates. As a result, more and more career-ready and work-integrated learning components, professional practice placements, and interdisciplinary subjects are more accessible than ever.

As a UoM student, there are a number of credit, grant and funding opportunities available to you if you undertake a project with Project Everest Ventures.

FUNDING AND GRANTS AVAILABLE

- **Melbourne Scholarships \$200 to \$10,000.**
- **Melbourne Mobility Awards.** The University of Melbourne offers a suite of scholarships and grants for students undertaking overseas study as part of their undergraduate or graduate coursework course. Some scholarships are awarded on academic merit and others to assist students who are experiencing disadvantage circumstances. These include:
 - The Melbourne Global Scholars Award, Jamakepe Foundation Scholarship and USA Foundation Scholarship providing a one-off payment of:
 - **\$1,000** for students undertaking overseas study for up to 12 weeks, or
 - **\$2,500** for students undertaking overseas study for 12 weeks or more
- Chancellor's Scholars, Kwong Lee Dow Scholars and students who entered the University between 2010- 2016 with an ATAR of at least 98 are guaranteed one **Melbourne Global Scholars Award** in their undergraduate degree.
- **OS HELP Loan.** Overseas Student HELP loans (OS-HELP) are provided by the Commonwealth government to eligible HECS-HELP students undertaking various international experiences for credit. This loan is added to your HECS/HELP debt.

UMOS	University of Melbourne Overseas Subject (UMOS)	All faculties	Equivalent to "one subject" - discuss with your course coordinator about available subject replacements. UMOSs are single subjects offered by all faculties, which are undertaken overseas.
SCIE30002	Science and Technology Internship	Science and Technology	Equivalent to 12.5 credit points.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS AND ELIGIBILITY

Applying for the Melbourne Mobility Awards

You must apply for the Melbourne Mobility Awards by completing the online application form before you depart Australia. In completing an application for a Melbourne Mobility Award, you will be considered for all Melbourne Mobility Awards for which you are eligible. You do not need to apply for individual awards.

To be eligible for this scholarship, you need to:

- be enrolled at the University of Melbourne in either an undergraduate degree or a graduate coursework degree
- intend to study overseas as part of a University of Melbourne Exchange or short term program or a University of Melbourne subject with an overseas component
- apply for a Melbourne Mobility Award before commencement of the overseas study program
- have not received a Melbourne Mobility Award for overseas study that was part of your current course

Each individual award has different eligibility requirements, based on period of travel, location, and activities undertaken. To find out more, [click here](#).

Applying for an OS-HELP Loan

If you receiving credit towards your degree during your overseas program, you are eligible to apply for an OS-HELP Loan. For more information, and how to apply for an OS-HELP Loan, [click here](#).

Some of the eligibility requirements for an OS-HELP loan include:

- Being an Australian citizen or hold a permanent humanitarian visa
- Being eligible for HECS-HELP
- Studying full time while overseas for credit which counts towards your UoM program

Applying for a UOMS

In order to enrol into a UOMS, submit this form at least 6 weeks before you depart for your Project Everest internship. You should only apply ONCE for each period of time you will be away. Make sure that you consult visit your faculty to check how this subject will fit into the overall completion of your degree. To apply, [click here](#).
