



# STUDY OVERSEAS

Process for applying for credit & funding for a  
Project Everest Ventures program at the **University  
of Adelaide**



## FUNDING AVAILABLE

Students may be eligible for [OS-HELP](#) funding of up to \$8,149 for Asian Destinations or \$6,791 for outside Asia.

Selected Project Everest Ventures programs are supported by a **\$3000 New Colombo Plan Grant** (Fiji and Timor-Leste).

## SO YOU'VE APPLIED THROUGH PEV, WHERE TO FROM HERE?

To be eligible for funding from the University of Adelaide your overseas program **must count for credit towards** your degree (or be contributing to course requirements) for the Australian course of study in which you are enrolled.

It is up to your [Faculty Advisor](#) as to whether they will approve some credit for your participation in this program.

To apply for credit, you must:

1. [Register your interest](#) in a Project Everest program in the Global Learning Application System (GLAS) via the Study Overseas website.
  - a. **NOTE:** To be considered for a **New Colombo Plan** grant, you must register via a specific GLAS application page. Please see further details below for programs that are eligible.
2. Complete only the first half of the 02 Faculty Approval questionnaire (all questions marked 'STUDENT').
3. Work through the remaining questionnaires in your application checklist, clicking 'Submit' at the bottom as you complete each one. There are some questionnaires that you may have to come back to later and submit.
4. If you have not received Faculty Approval within 3 weeks, please follow up your Faculty to request approval.

5. Study Overseas does not advise you to pay a deposit for your program until you have received approval from your Faculty to participate in the program.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDING

To be eligible for funding, the following questionnaires in [your GLAS registration](#) will need to be completed and submitted:

- Confirm your bank details are up to date
- Credit Eligibility and OS-HELP Verification (completed by your Faculty)
- Host Application: Your Host Acceptance Documents

## OS-HELP LOAN

**OS-HELP** is a government loan scheme where eligible students can borrow up to \$8,149 for Asian Destinations or \$6,791 for outside Asia to undertake some of their course of study overseas. Your OS-HELP loan is added to your accumulated HECS debt.

Along with completing the questionnaires in your GLAS application, you will need to meet the [eligibility requirements](#) for the loan.

If you meet the eligibility criteria, you may collect an OS-HELP form from **Ask Adelaide in Hub Central**. Please note, once you are assessed as eligible to receive the loan, it takes 3-4 weeks for those funds to be deposited into your account.
